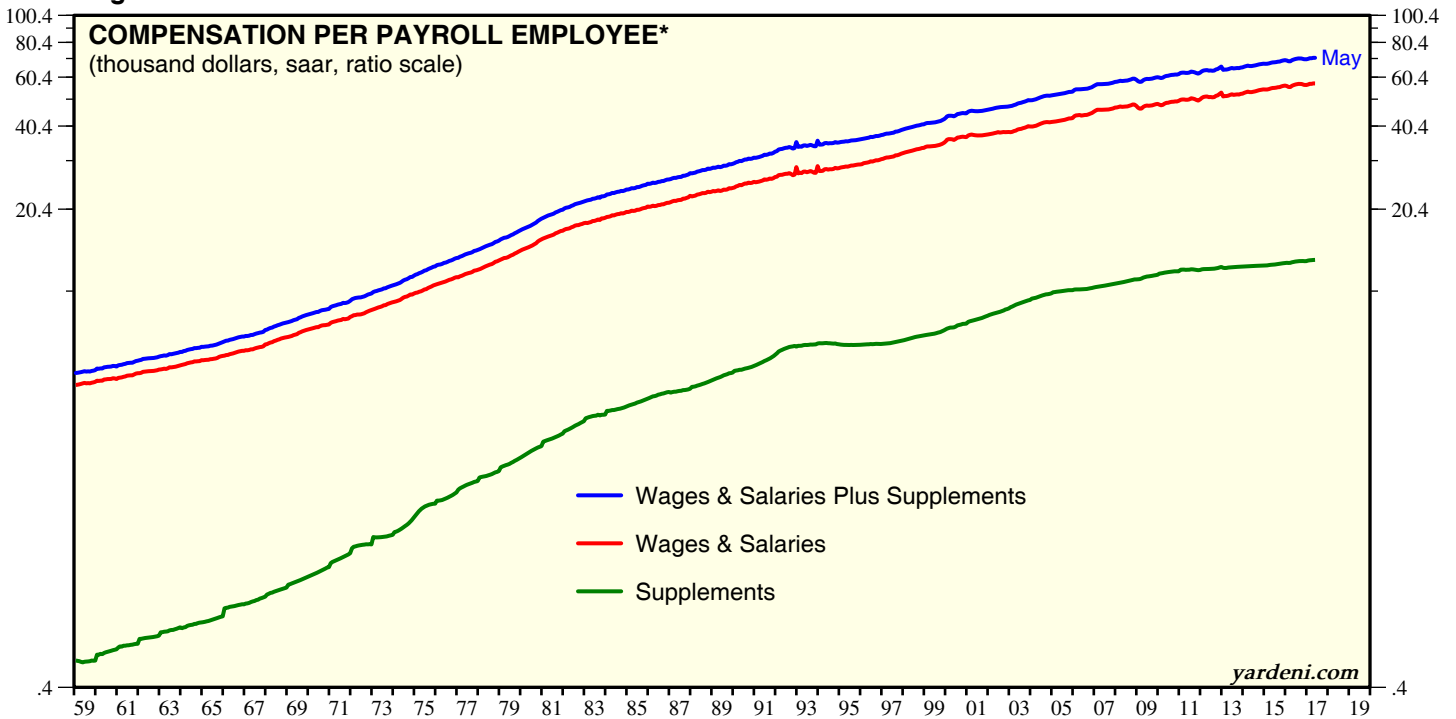

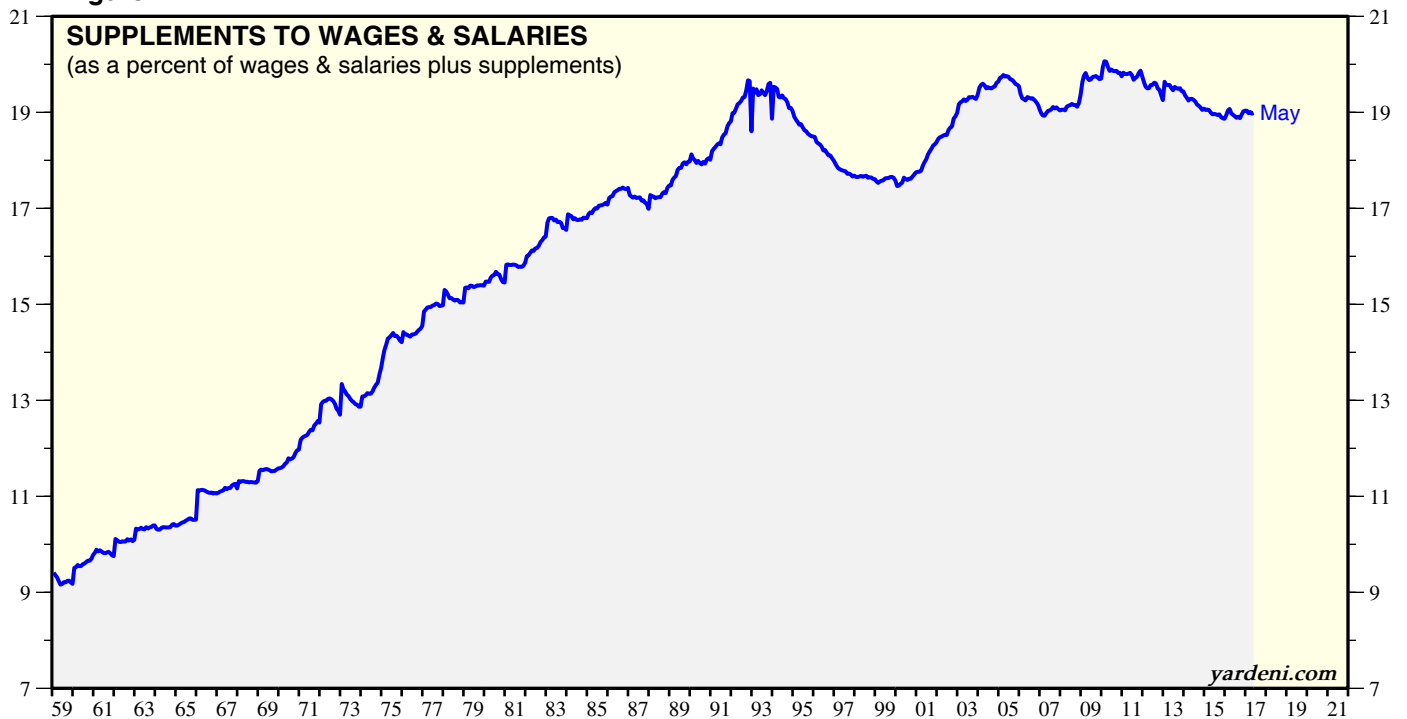

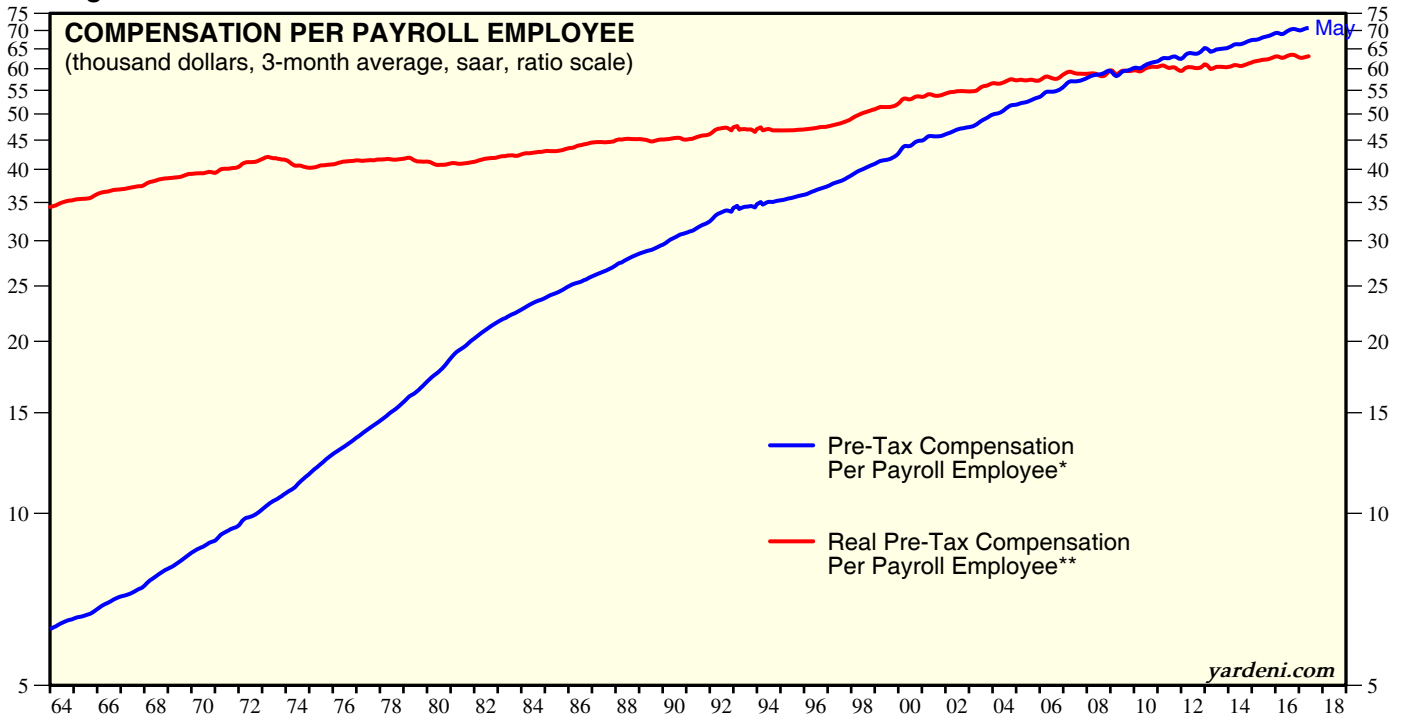

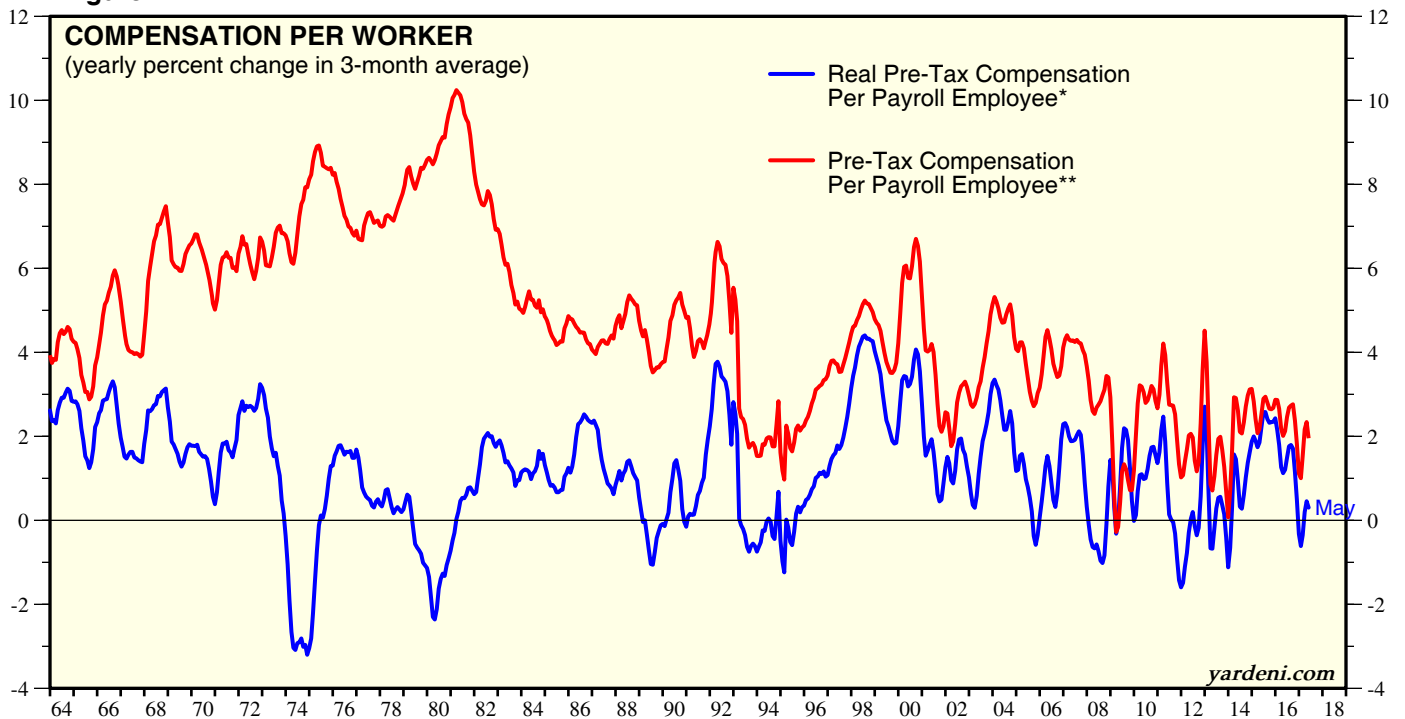

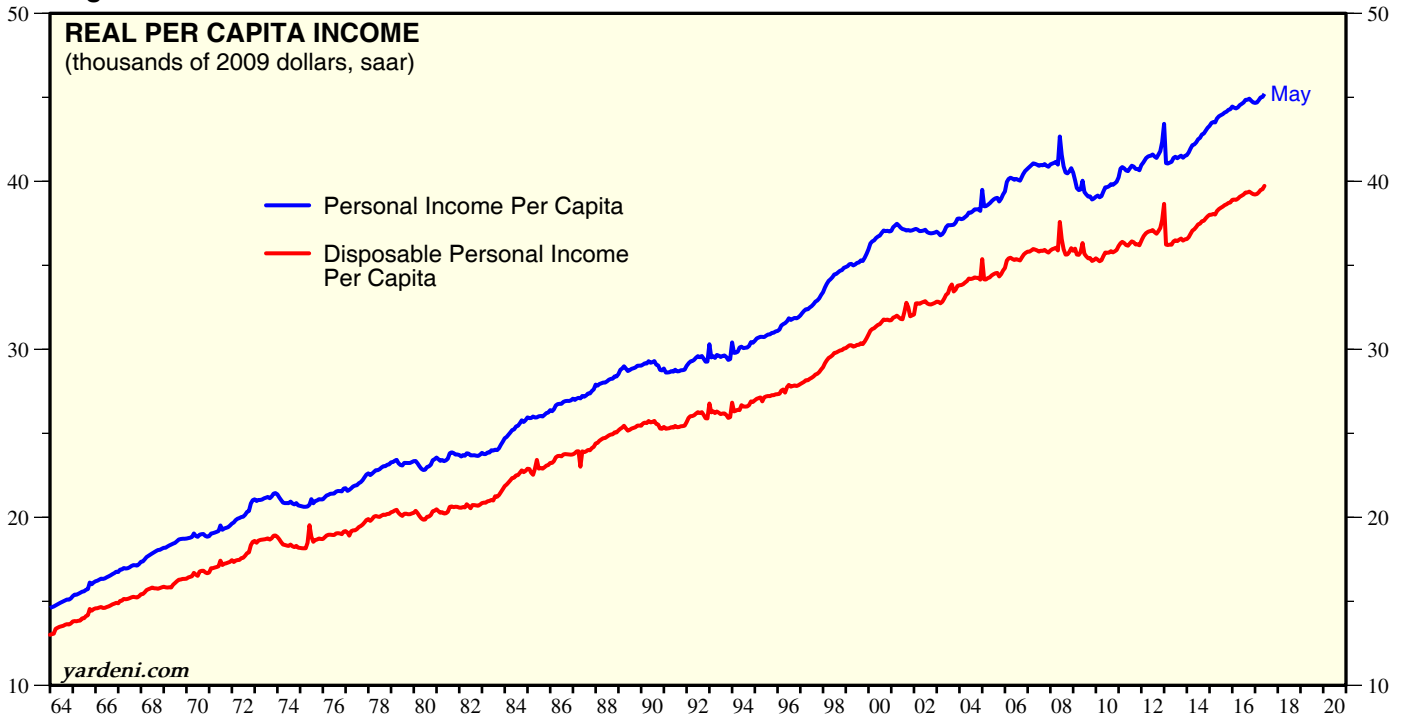
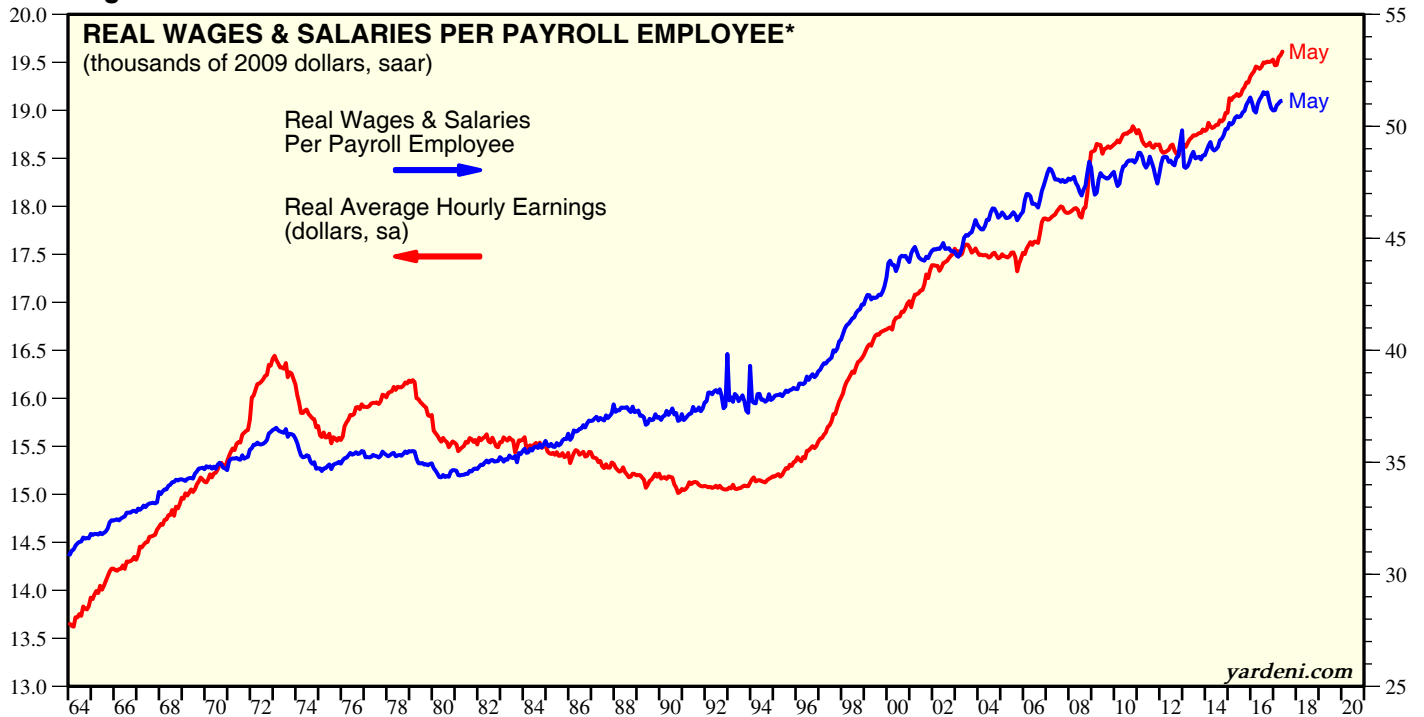


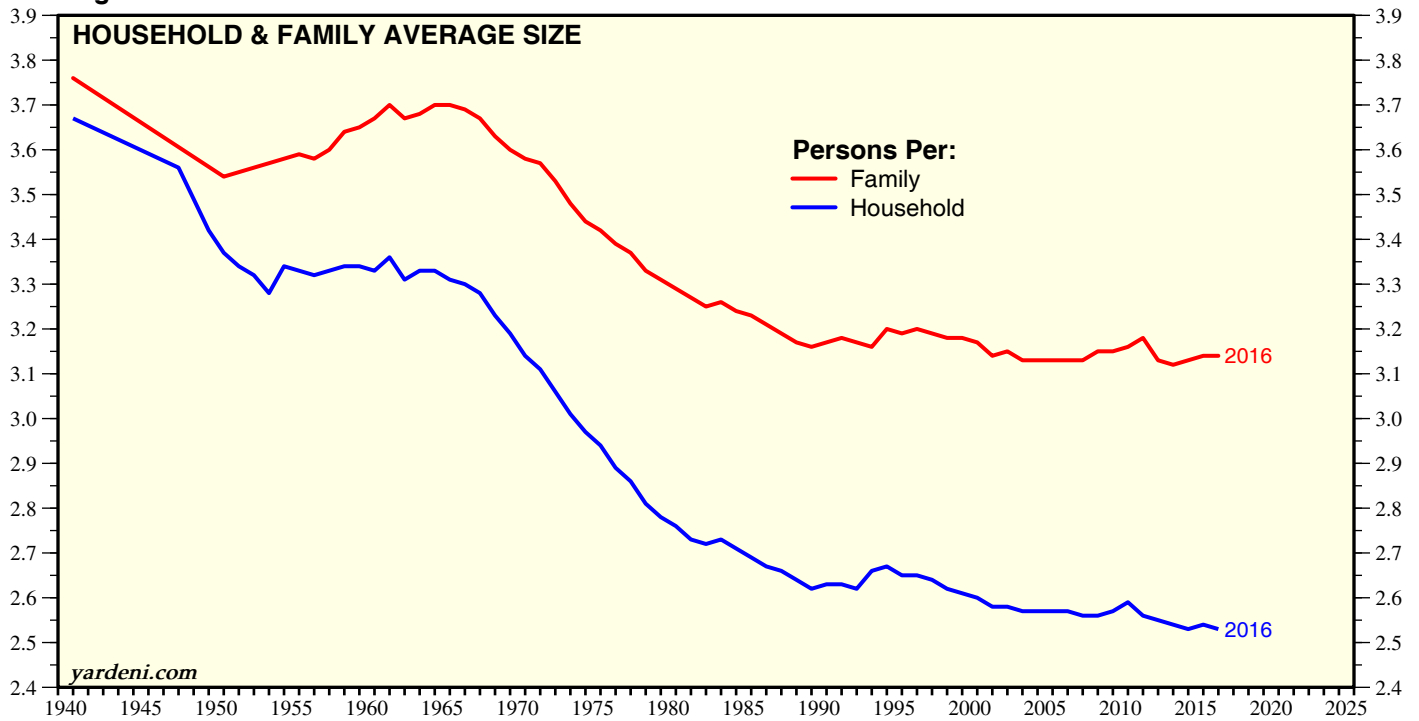

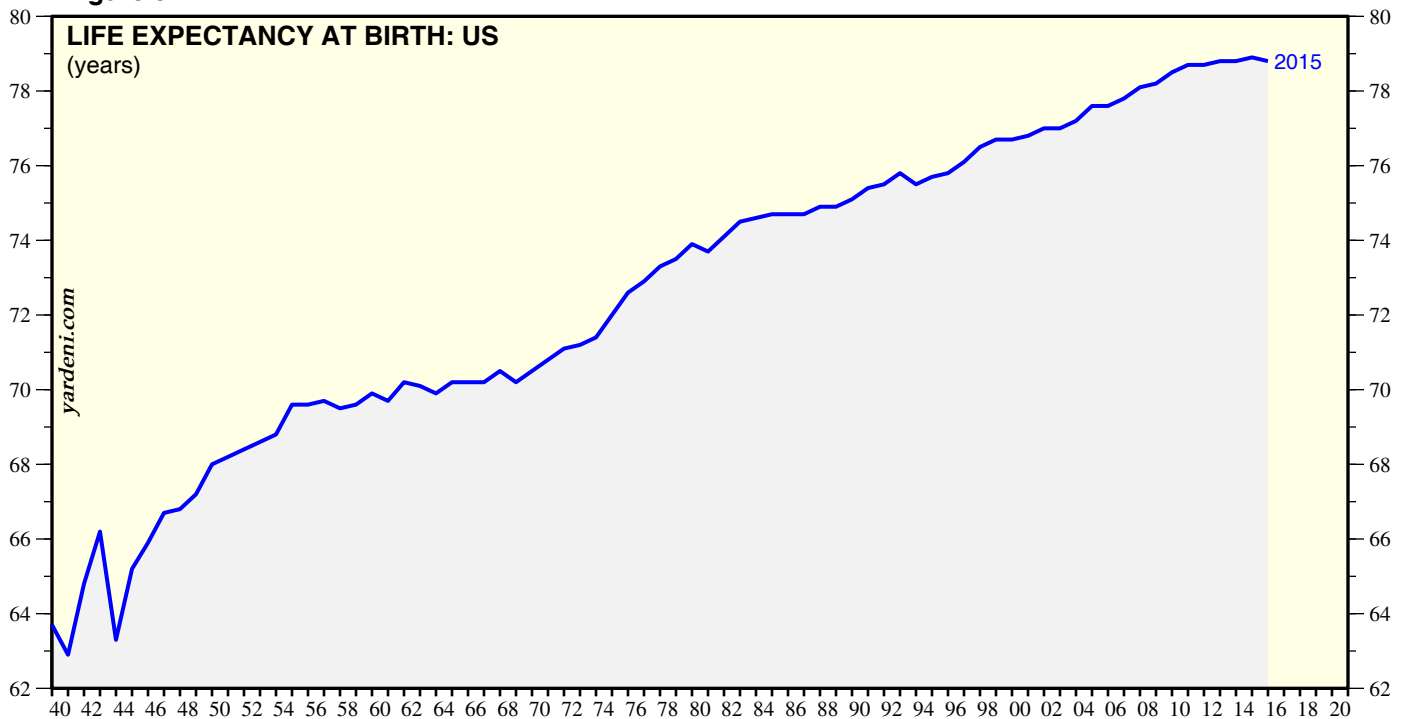

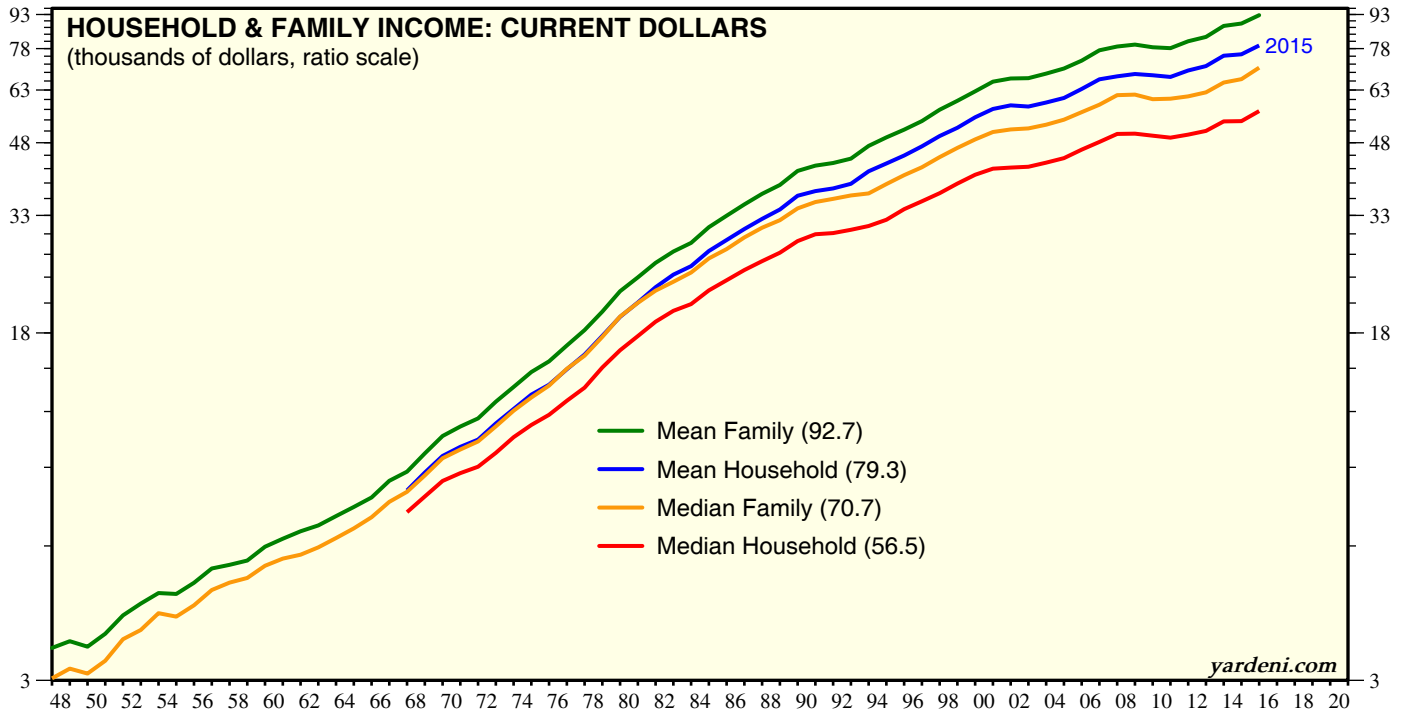

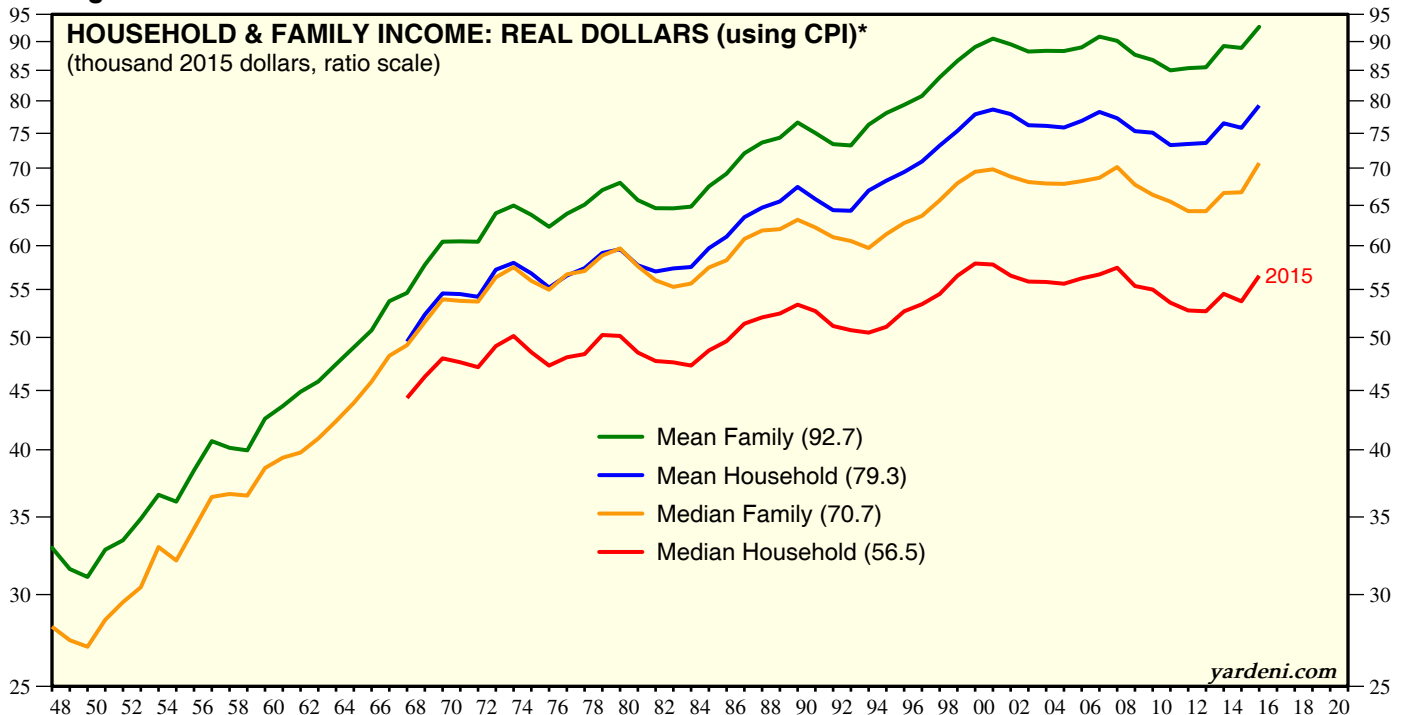
# Household vs. Family Income

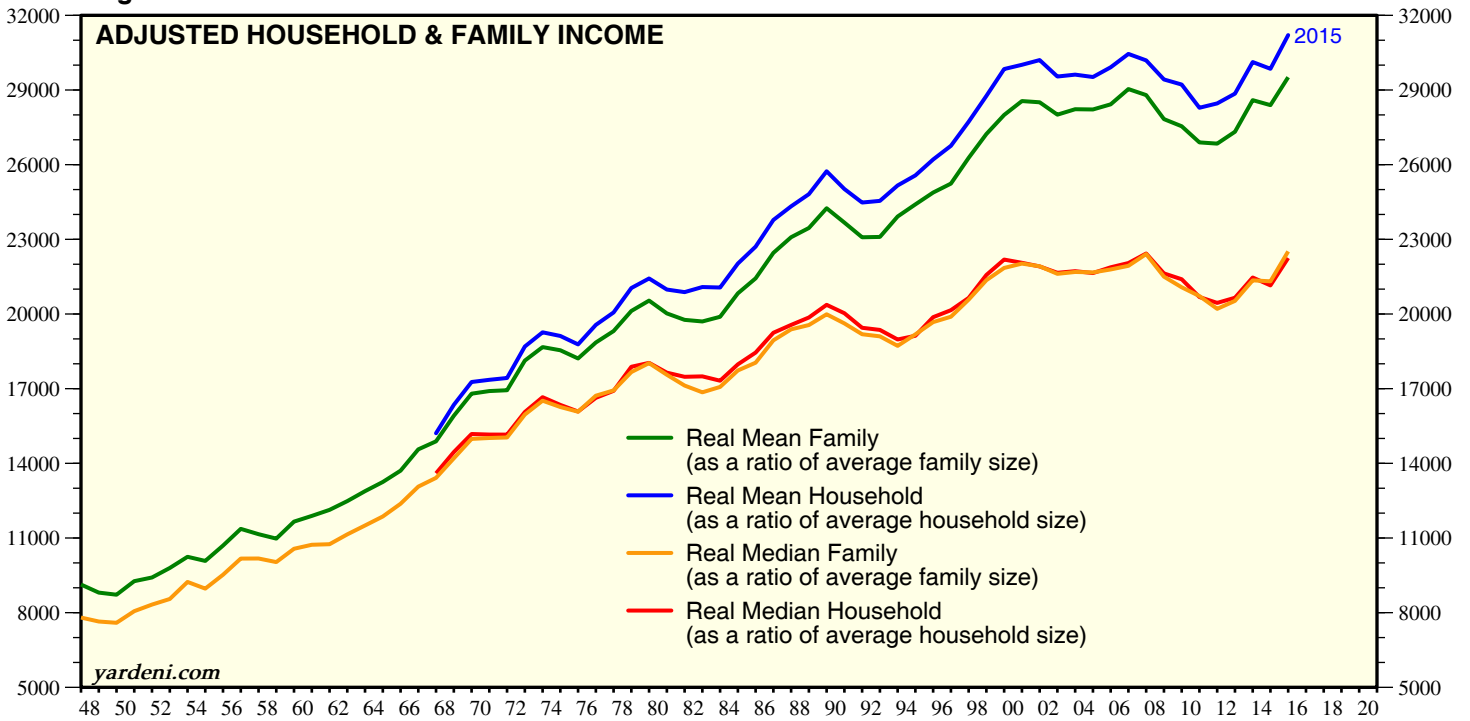

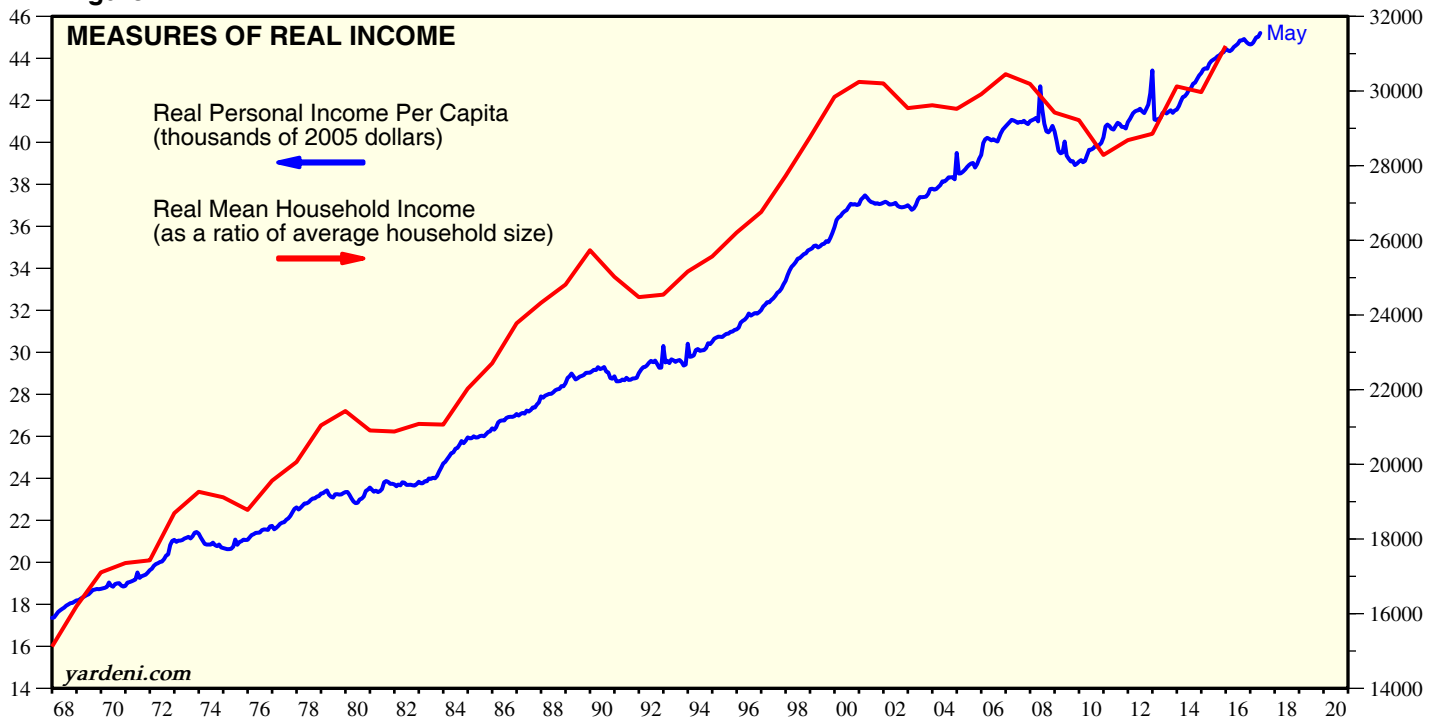

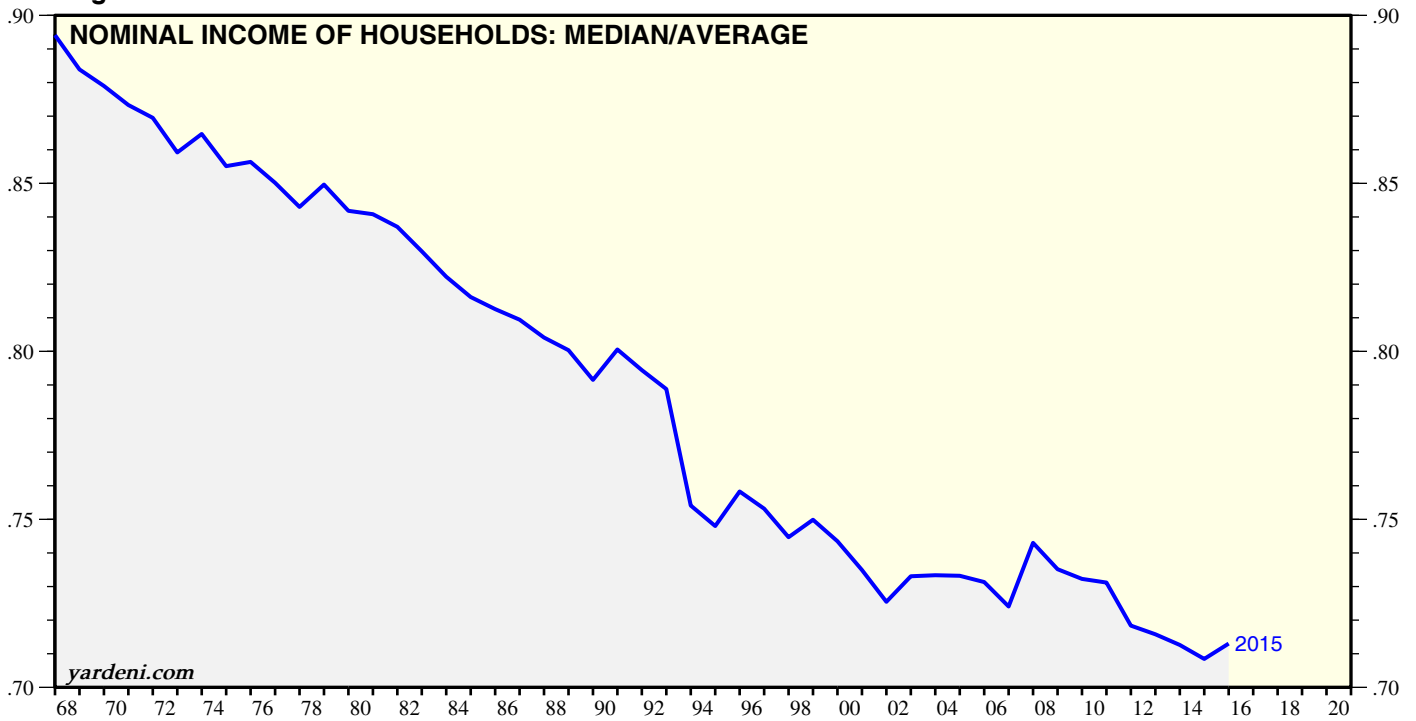

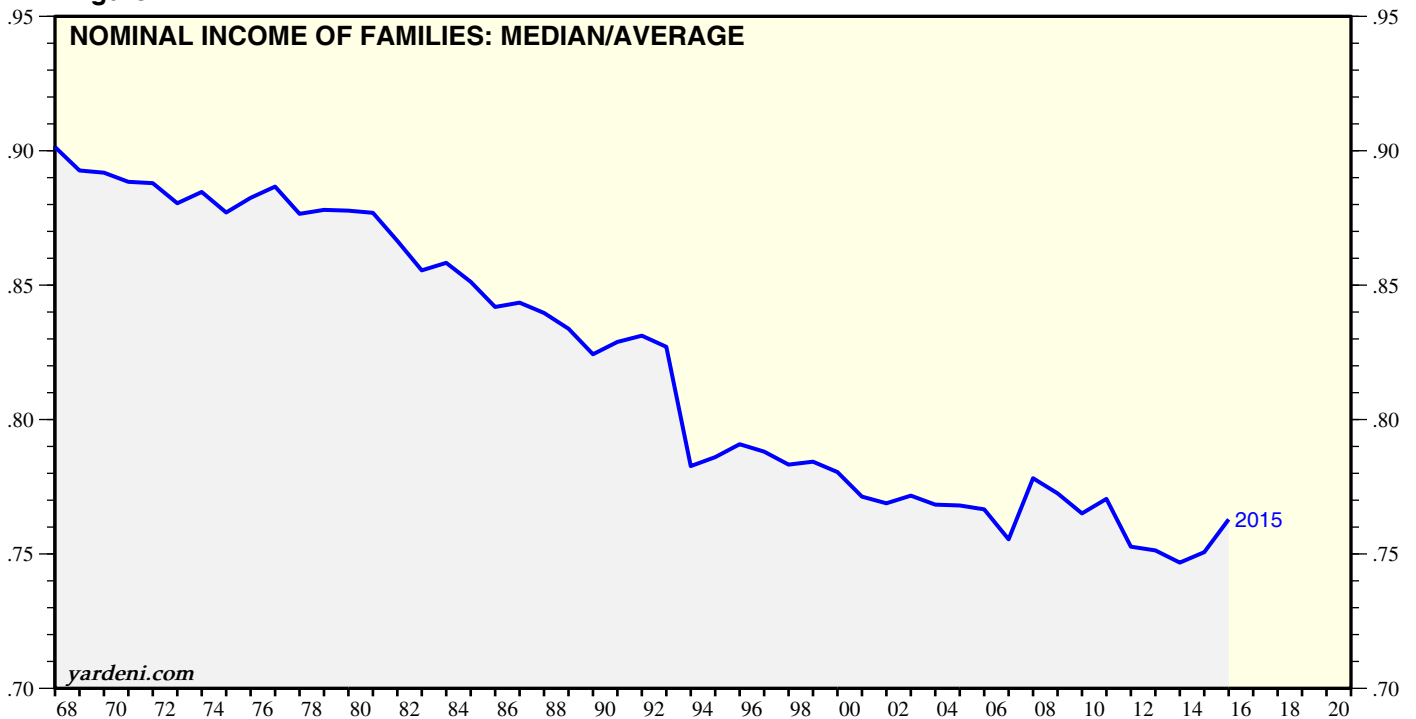

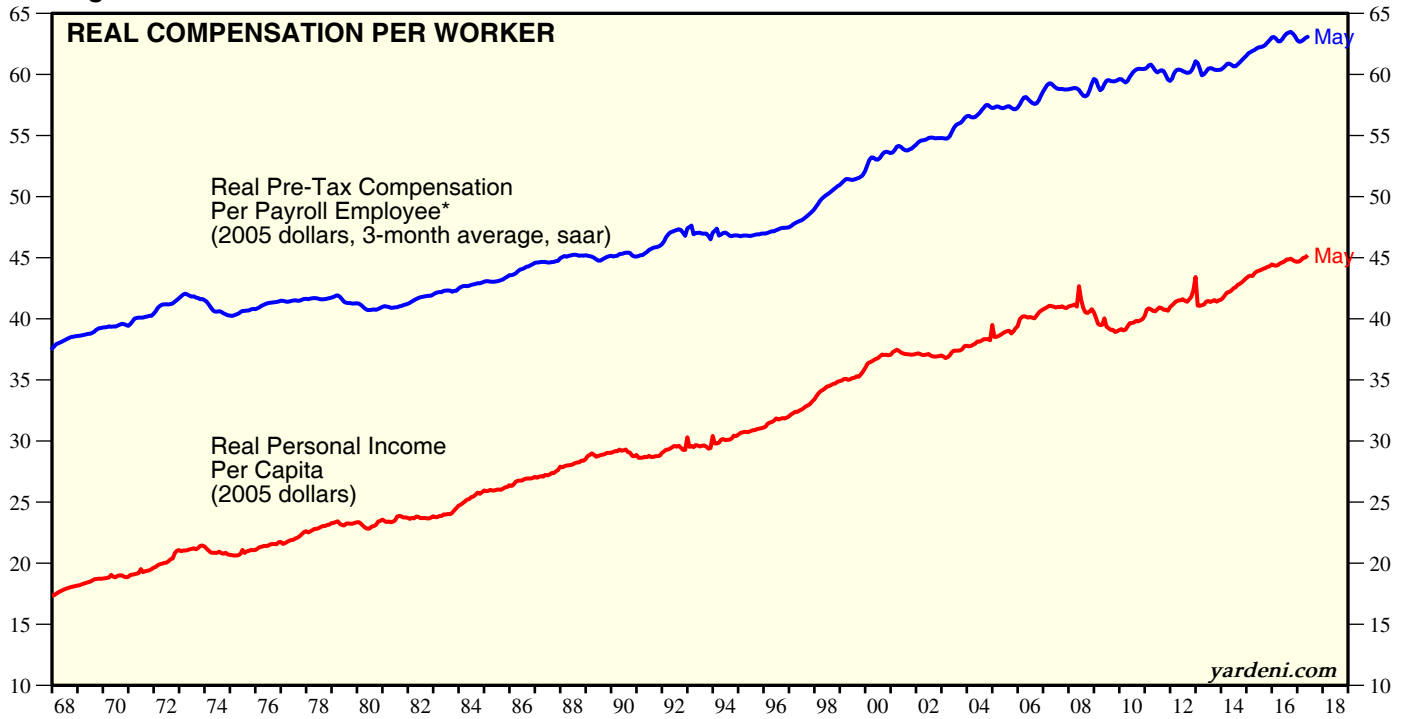

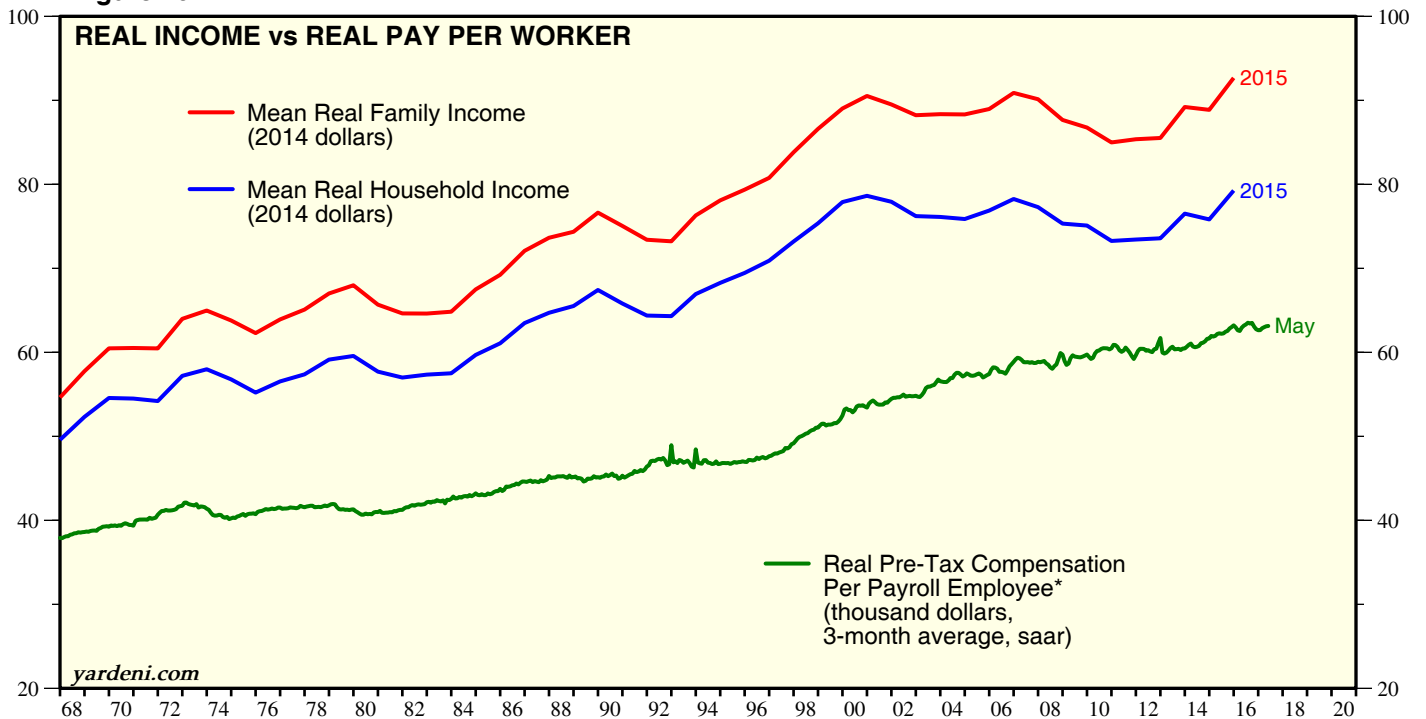

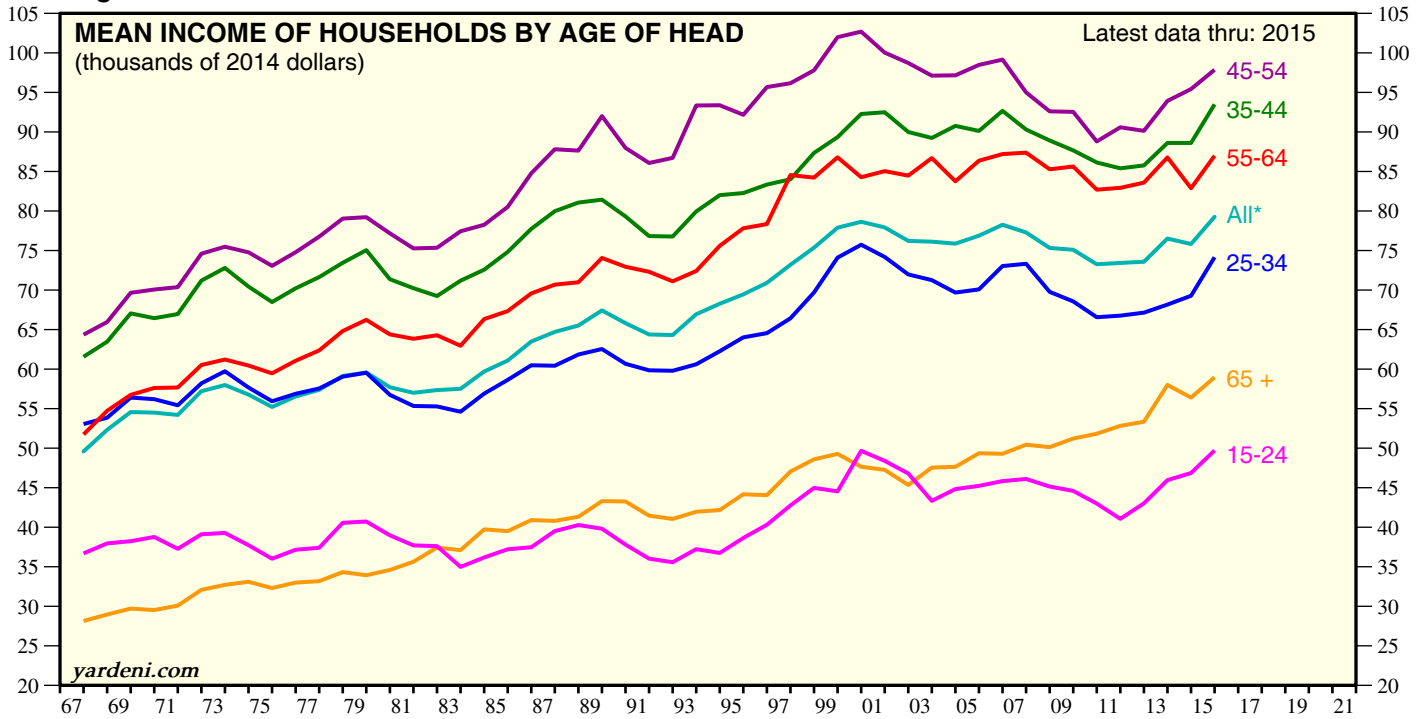

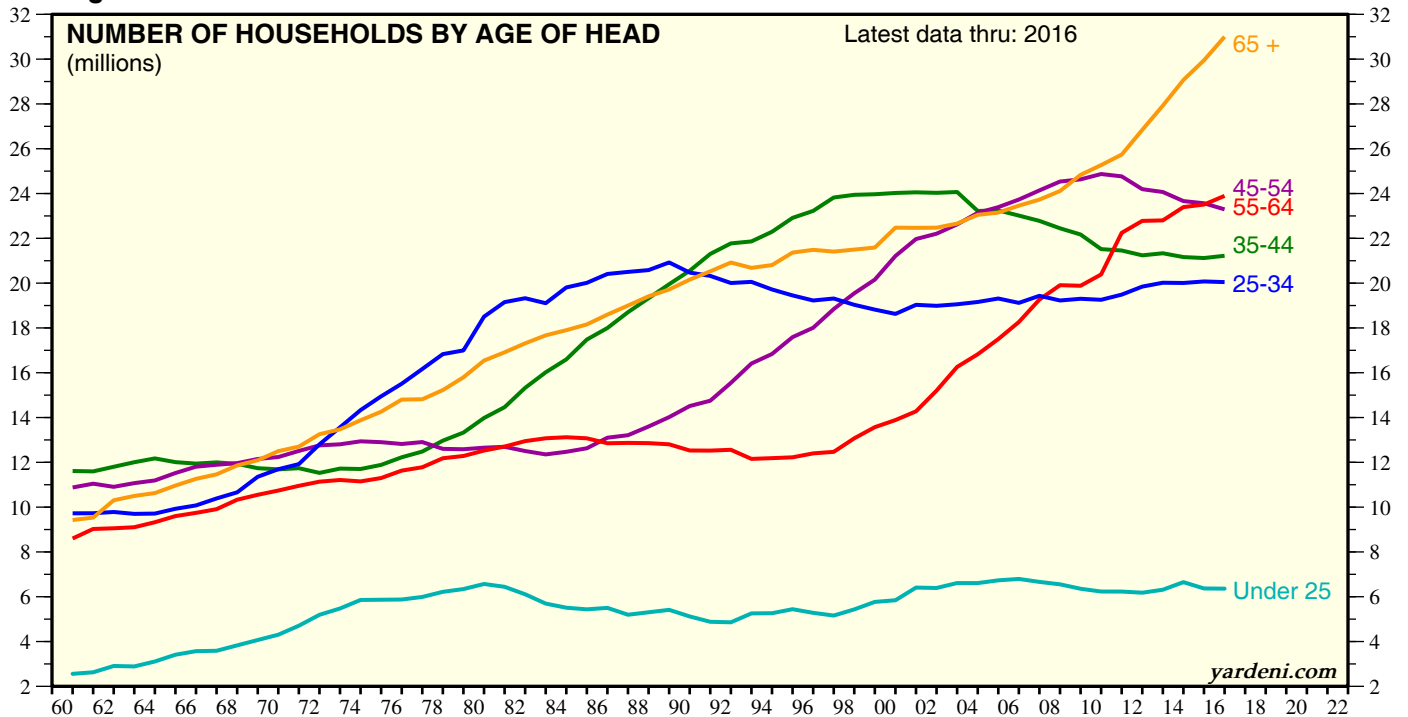

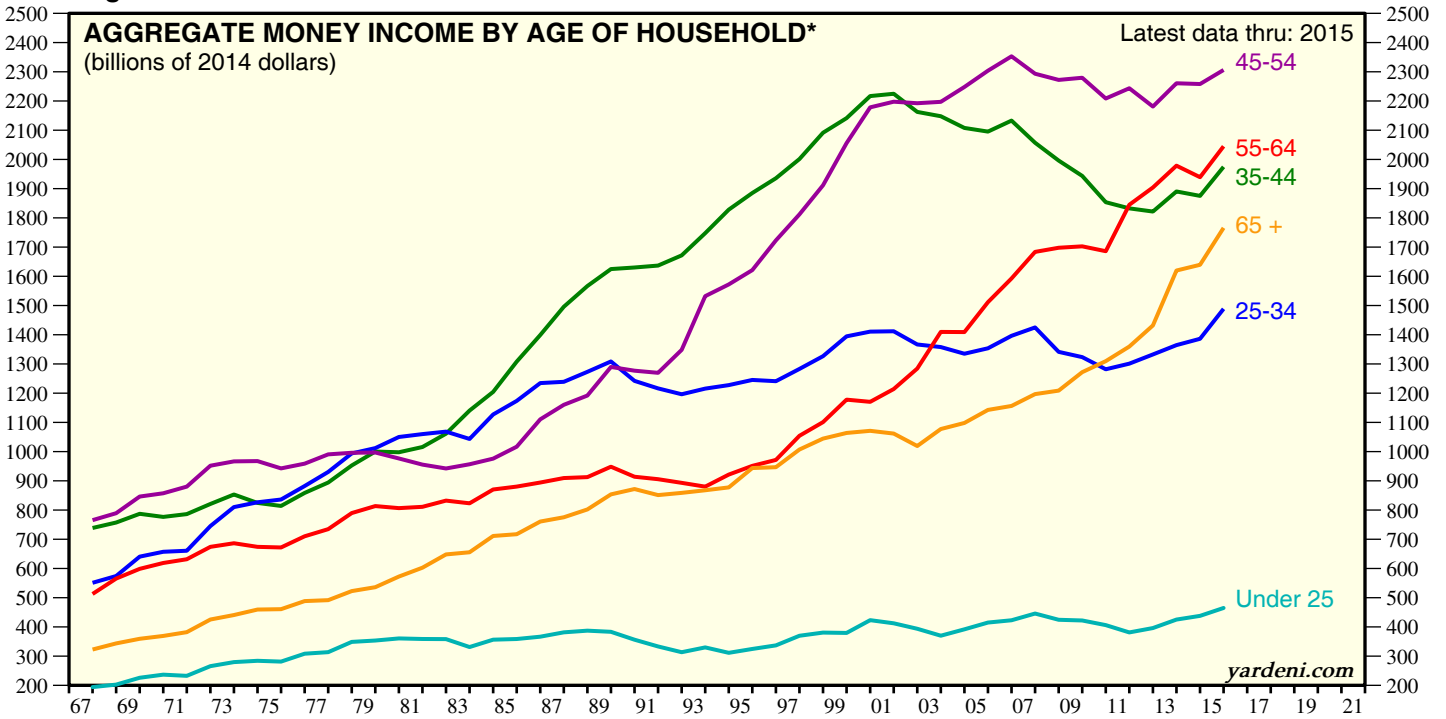

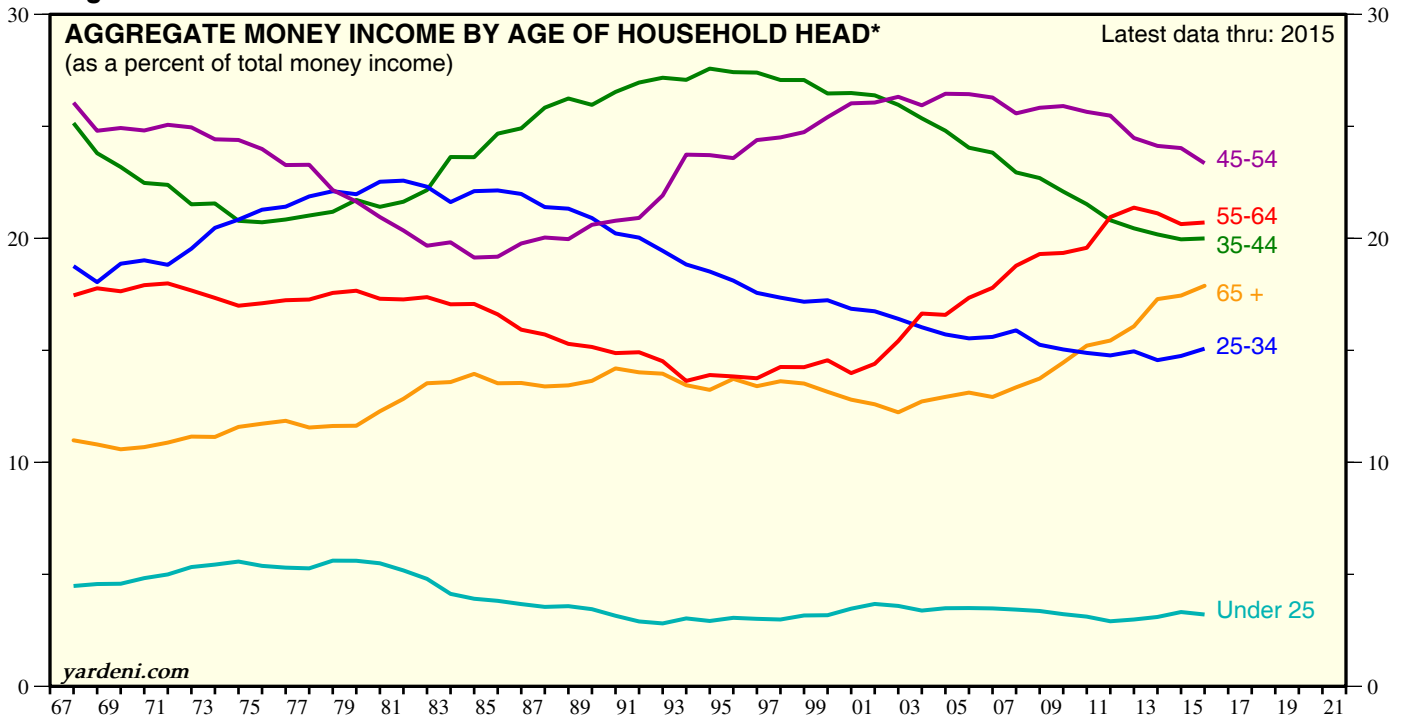

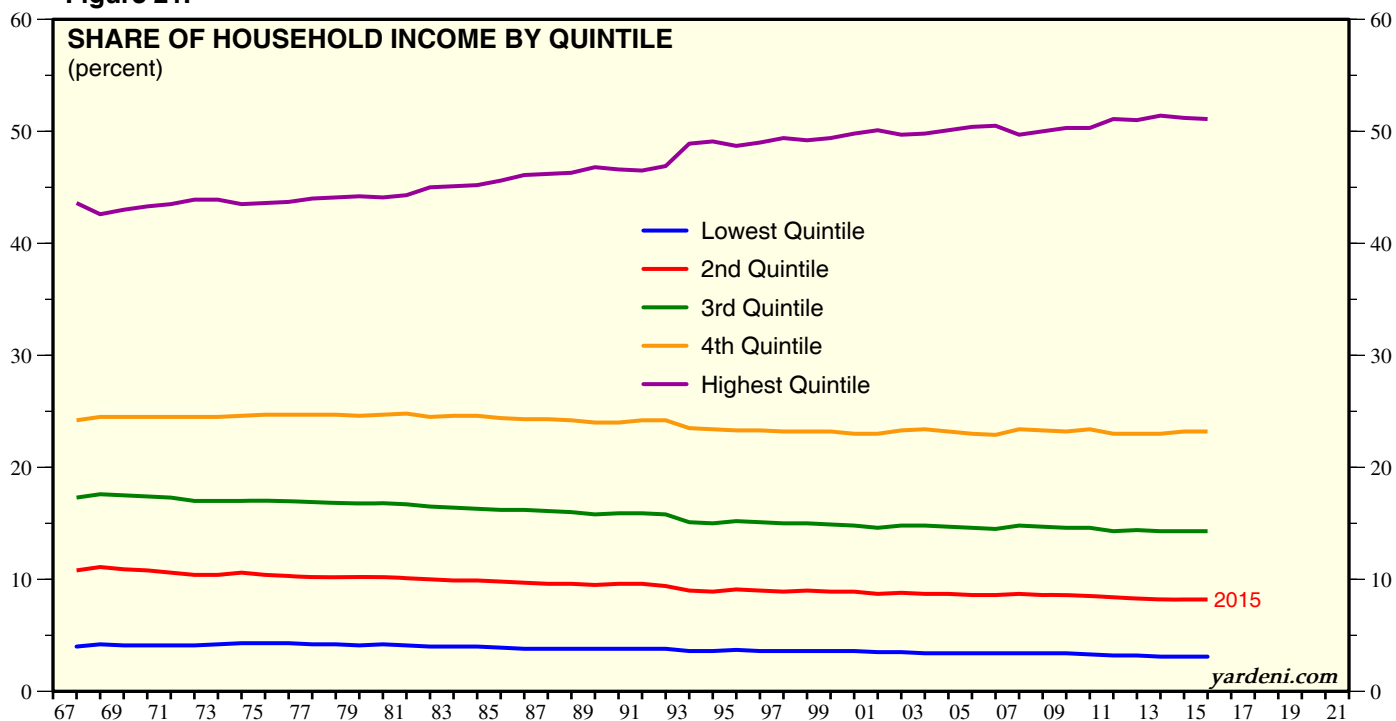
